- **Organization Structure and Program Management**

CKHA has adopted a program management model to better serve patients and families. Program management means coordinating efforts among highly related members of the interdisciplinary team centred around a patient population. CKHA has seven programs:

1. Chronic Disease Management, Family Medicine, Rural, Seniors & Indigenous Health
2. Diagnostics and Therapeutics
3. Emergency, Ambulatory Care & Patient Flow
4. Medicine & Critical Care
5. Mental Health & Addictions
6. Surgery
7. Women & Children’s
